Before submitting your file

- You should export your project without having any mastering tools such as compression and limiting on the master bus of your track
- Please submit your mix down with sufficient headroom (peak level max. -3dB)
- Your tracks and .zip folders should be clearly labelled Digital Release: 1_Track_Name_MixdownV1_44.1kHz_16bit 2_Track_Name_MixdownV2_48kHz_24bit usw. Vinyl Release: A1_Track_Name_MixdownV1_44.1kHz_16bit B1_Track_Name_MixdownV2_48kHz_24bit B2_Track_Name_MixdownV3_66.2kHz_32bit
